Baruti Kafele, former principal of Hubbard Middle School and now a noted educational consultant, was the guest speaker at UC TEAMS Charter School in Plainfield, NJ.

Principal Kafele not only administered schools in Plainfield, but also served as principal in East Orange, and Newark. During his tenure in these schools he was credited with transforming these institutions into highly productive places of learning.

Kafele stated that he became so disturbed with the mis-education of African American youngsters that he chose to leave his school to assist educators in much needed change.
