We have a parent community organization (PATCO) that helps each family discover its service niche within the school. The system is flexible so that every parent can find meaningful ways to contribute to the school and its mission (i.e. classroom support, help in the office, hot lunch servers, technology advisors, translation team, materials' preparation, data entry team, health aide, etc.). Ideally, each family will *commit to a few hours per month to help the school fulfill its mission*. We do not want our families to see family involvement as a burden, but rather, as an opportunity and a privilege.
